

Study Guide Chapter 1 Spanish 1

✚ Remember: You took notes for this chapter. Don't neglect to use them while studying. You also have a vocabulary list that will help you study.

I. Primer paso:

- a. Know all the phrases used to greet someone and say goodbye.

Example: Buenas tardes, Buenos días, chao, adios

- b. Know how to introduce people, and yourself to others.

For example: Hola ésta es mi amiga se llama Carly.

Hola me llamo Denise, ¿Y tú cómo te llamas?

- c. Know how to ask someone how they are, and respond the question.

For example: ¿Cómo estás?

Estoy bastante bien, ¿Y tú?

- d. Subject Pronouns. (yo and tú) You should be able to read a sentence in the target language and identify which subject pronoun is implied.

II. Segundo paso:

- a. Know how to ask someone how old they are, and state how old you are.

- b. Know your numbers 1-30 including how to spell them.

- c. Know how to ask someone where they are from, and how to state where you are from.

- d. You need to be able to form question phrases with question words. Using the correct punctuation. For example: ¿Cómo estás? ¿Cómo te llamas? ¿Cuántos años tienes? ¿De dónde eres?

III. Tercer paso

- a. Know how to ask someone what they like and dislike.

- b. Know how to state what you like, and what you don't like.

- c. Vocabulario: all the nouns in your vocabulary need to be memorized, and you must know how to spell them correctly. (including accents)

- d. Definite articles. You need to know the definite article that goes with each noun on the vocabulary. Example: el voleibol la pizza.
